Other summative evaluation measures are reported to help stakeholders judge the work the student completed</p> <p>(25 points)</p>	<p>The project assesses student learning but the measures might be misaligned with the goals; outcomes or summative evaluations are only superficially completed</p> <p>(13 points)</p>	<p>The project does not assess student learning. Holistic	<p>The project shows a strong awareness of how the connections between individual elements fit into harmonious relationships, and how those relationships help assemble a unified whole.</p> <p>(10 points)</p>	<p>The project only shows moderate awareness of how the connections between individual elements fit into harmonious relationships, and how those relationships help assemble a unified whole.</p> <p>(5 points)</p>	<p>The project shows a little to now awareness of how the connections between individual elements fit into harmonious relationships, and how those relationships help assemble a unified whole.</p> <p>(1 point)</p>
