On-topic

How well are connections being drawn between readings/discussion/class project/and course learning outcomes?

Highly developed (3 points)

Shows evidence that the student is drawing connections between readings/discussion/class project and course learning outcomes.

Partially developed (2 points)

Shows some evidence of reflection, but writing may not connect to course learning outcomes.

Under-developed (1 point)

Shows little evidence of reflection, mostly summarizes topics from readings or discussion.

How well is the paper is written and adhere to APA style? Does it fit the length and formatting requirements?

Highly developed (3 points)

Is almost completely free of grammatical errors and adheres to APA style. Adheres to all length and formatting requirements.

Partially developed (2 points)

Has minor grammatical errors or violations of APA style. Deviates in minor ways from length and formatting requirements.

Under-developed (1 point)

Has major grammatical errors or violations of APA style. Deviates in major ways from length and formatting requirements.

Unsatisfactory (3 points)

The project shows little alignment to the chosen instructional strategy (or justification for departures).

Quality

Communicates

Highly detailed; the showcase communicates the project clearly.

Satisfactory (6 points)

The showcase mostly stands alone, but reviewers are left with key questions unanswered.

Unsatisfactory (3 points)

The showcase does not clearly communicate the essential details about the project.

Non-existent (0 points)

Did not complete the assignment.

Use of theory, research, and strategy

How well does the final showcase incorporate lessons learned through research, theory, and knowledge of instructional strategy?

Exemplary (9 points)

Significant evidence of relying on research, theory, and instructional strategy.

Satisfactory (6 points)

Moderate evidence of relying on research, theory, and instructional strategy; may include superficial evidence while missing the big picture.

Unsatisfactory (3 points)

Little evidence of relying on research, theory, and instructional strategy.

Non-existent (0 points)

Did not complete the assignment.

Professionalism

How professional is the final showcase?

Exemplary (9 points)

Meets standards for professionalism. Showcase and materials are of high quality. Professional language/terminology used correctly throughout. Materials are almost completely free of grammatical errors, etc.

Satisfactory (6 points)

Meets most standards for professionalism, but may show some sloppiness in how materials were prepared. Language/terminology may occasionally be informal. Materials have noticeable grammatical errors, etc.

Unsatisfactory (3 points)

Meets few standards for professionalism. Materials are of low quality. Language/terminology is consistently informal. Materials have significant grammatical errors, etc.

Non-existent (0 points)

Rigor

How well does the final showcase exemplify the quality of rigor?

Exemplary (9 points)

The showcase shows significant evidence of thought, work, and attention to detail.

Satisfactory (6 points)

The showcase shows moderate evidence of thought, work, and attention to detail.

Unsatisfactory (3 points)

The showcase shows little evidence of thought, work, and attention to detail.
